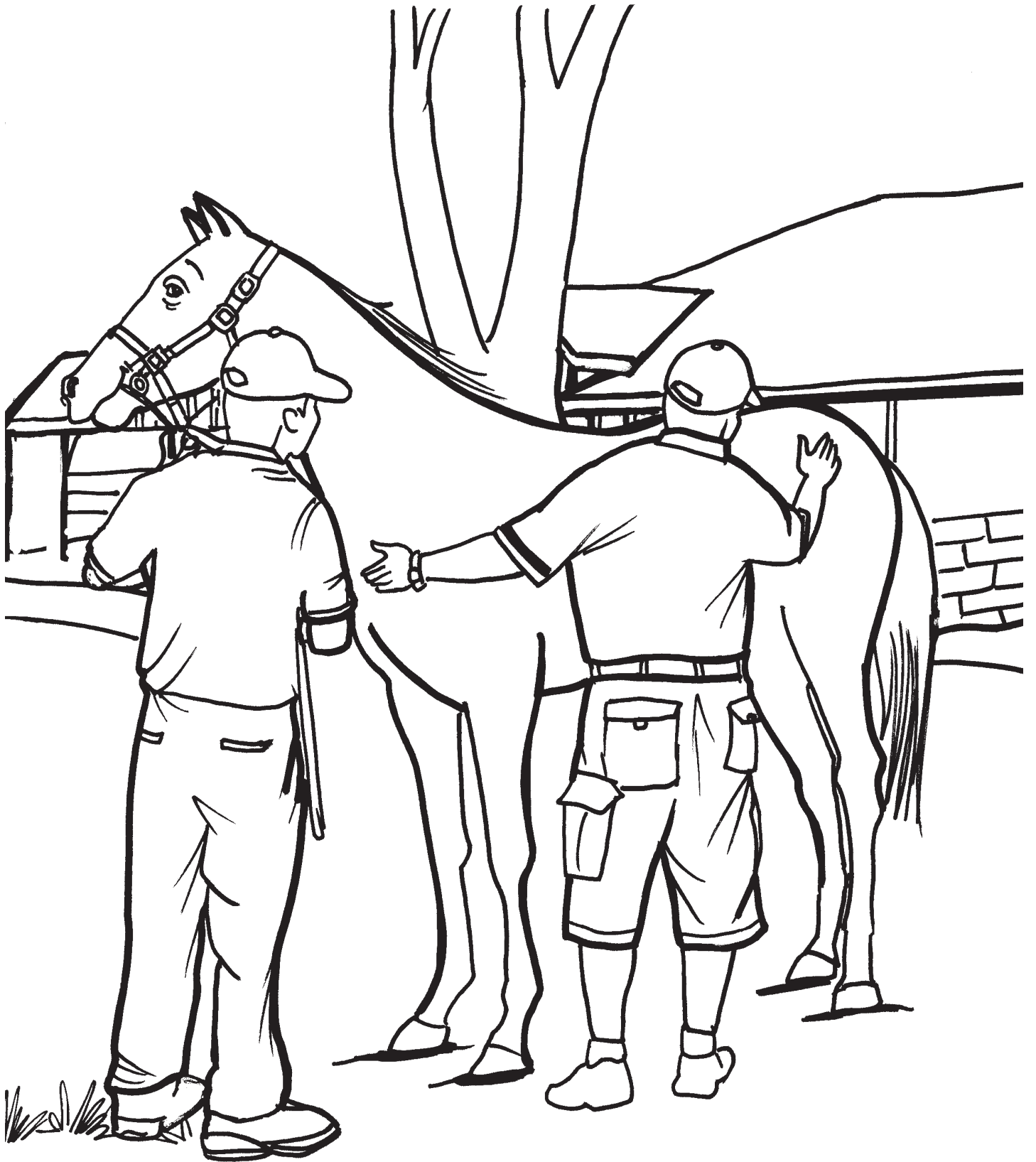
**Saturday mornings during the race meets, kids enjoy fun games and activities such as trying on jockey silks at Breakfast with the Works.**



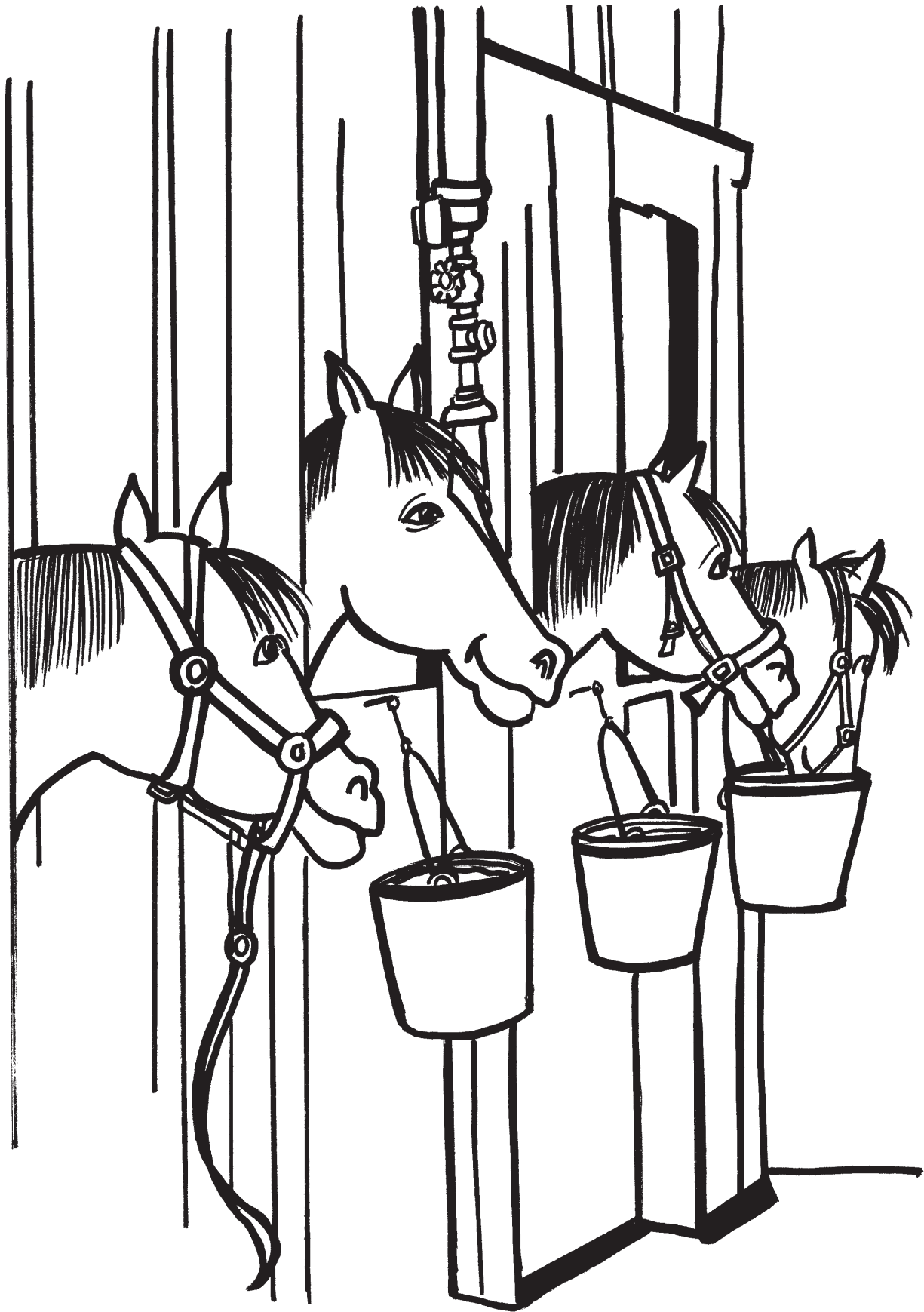
Horses like to visit when they have a break from their morning workout.



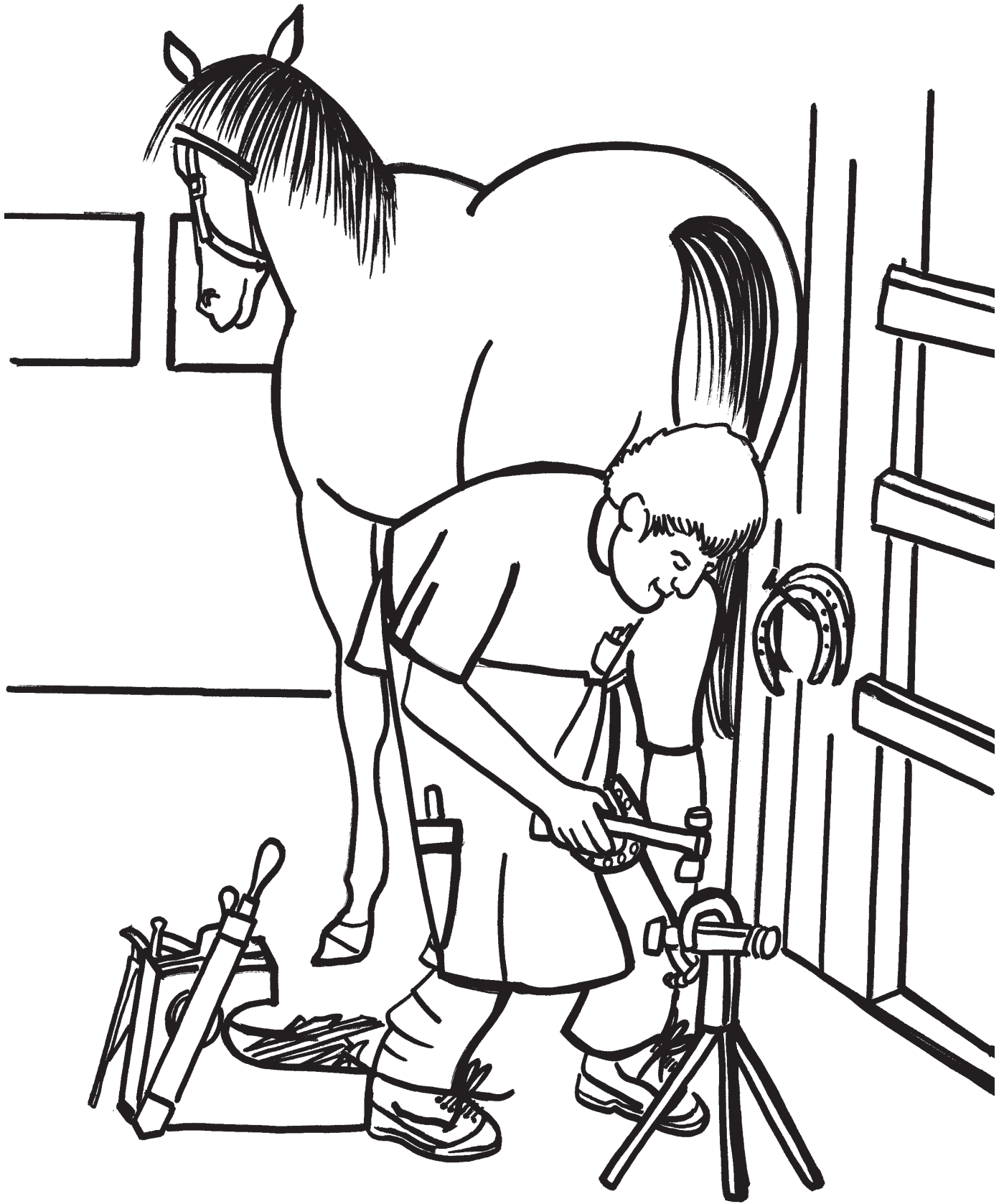
Horses are sold at the Keeneland Sales through an auction.



Horses for sale are inspected before the auction.



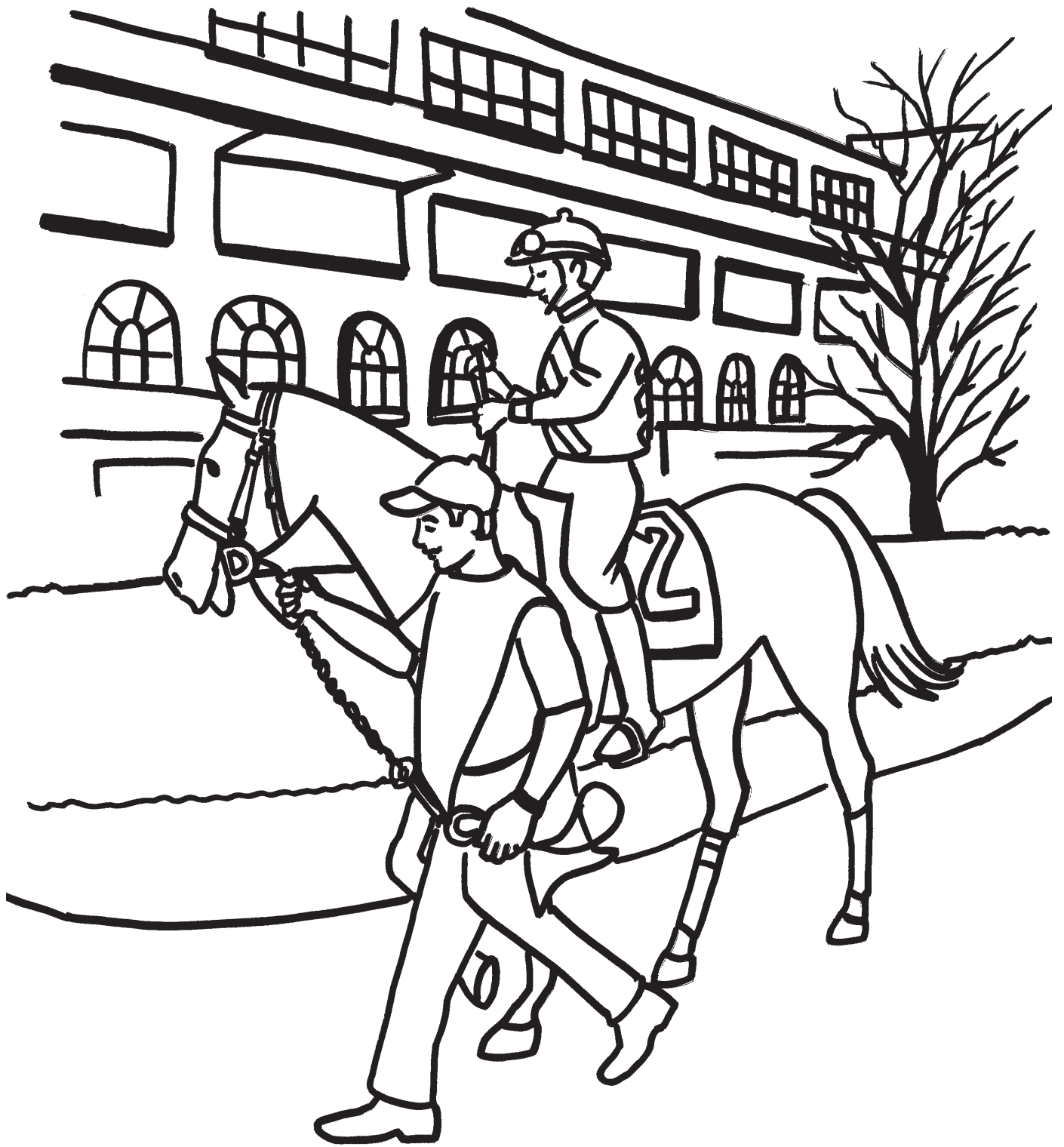
Horses stay in barns on the grounds at Keeneland.



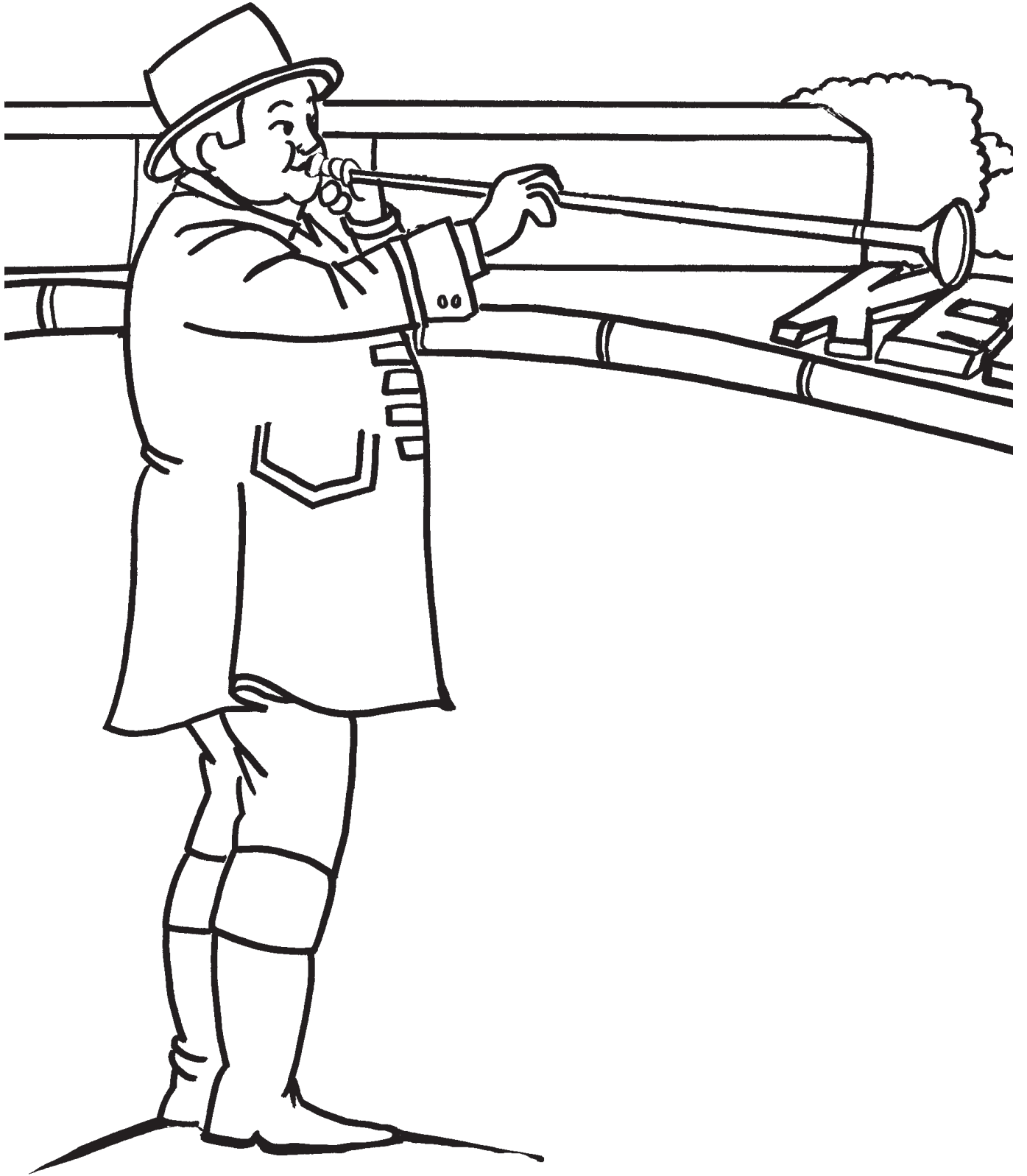
Many people help take good care of the horses, like the ferrier that puts the horses' shoes on.

Every race begins with the Call to the Post.



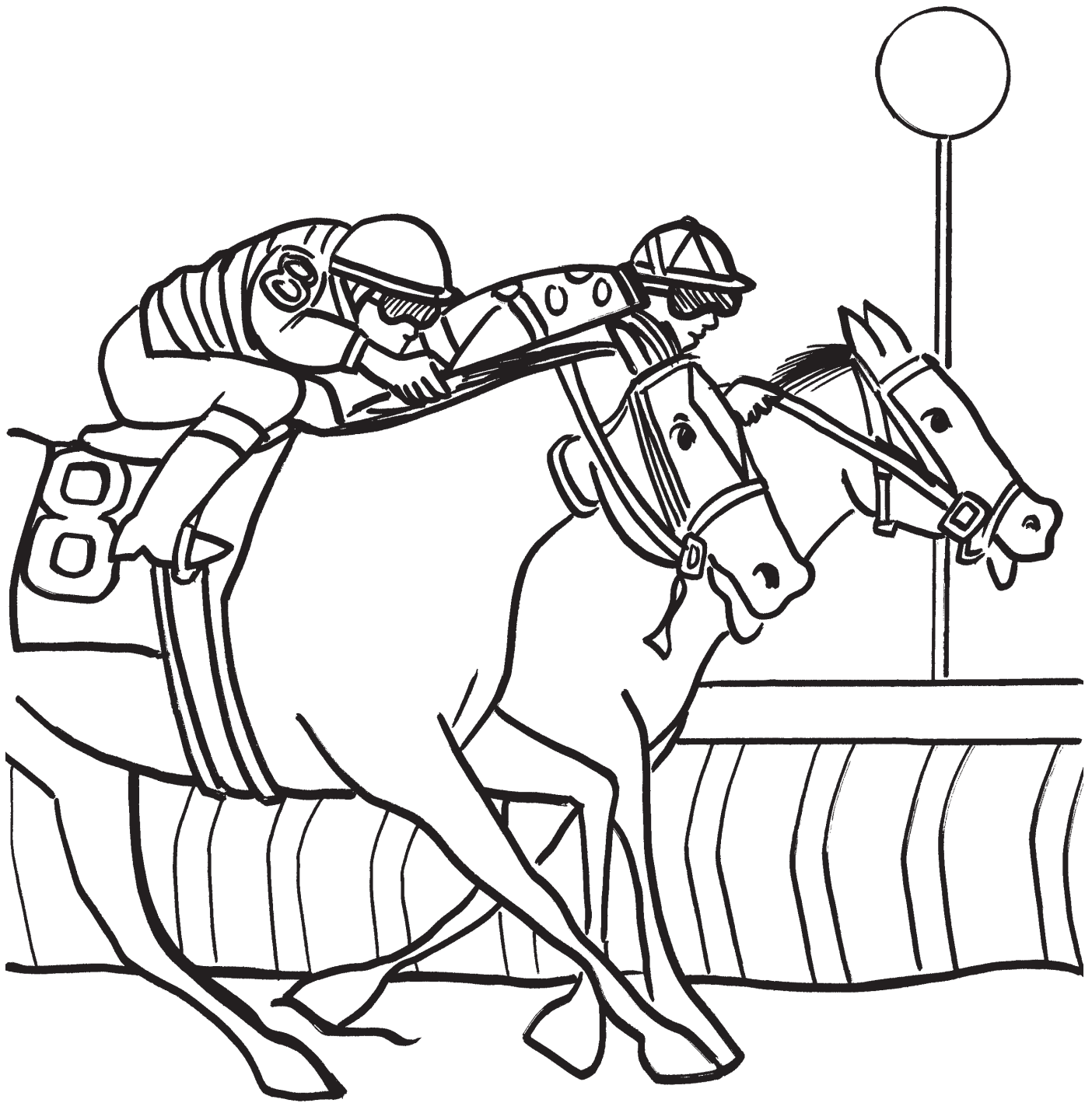
Horses come out of the starting gate to begin the race.

Race fans cheer on their favorite horse.



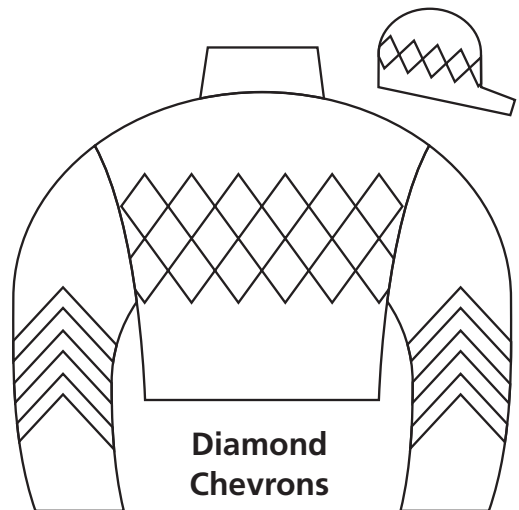
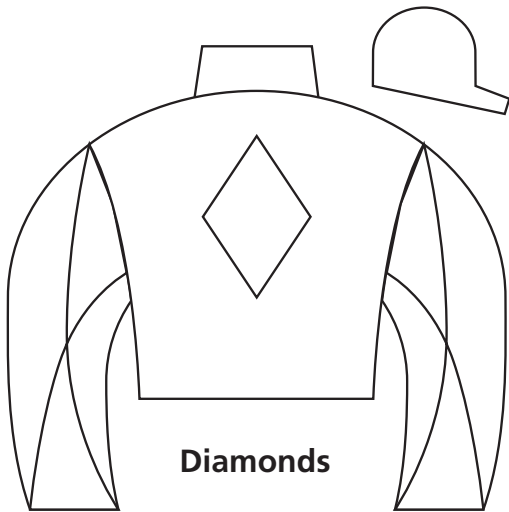
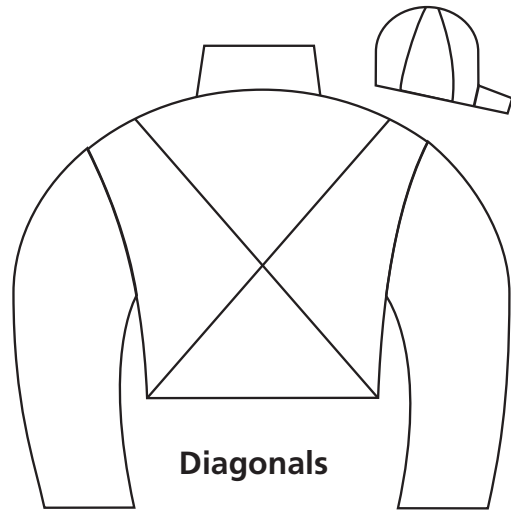
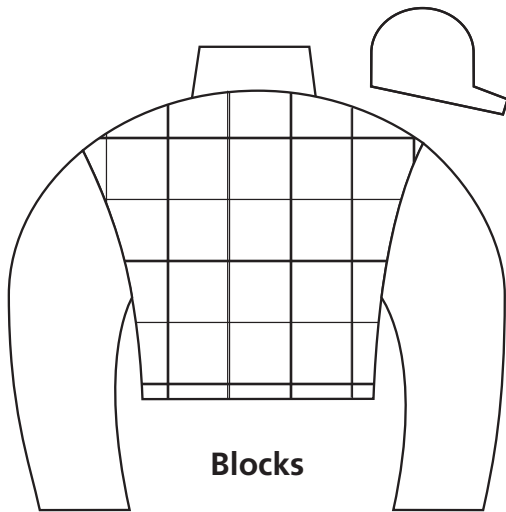
The horse that crosses the finish line first is the winner!

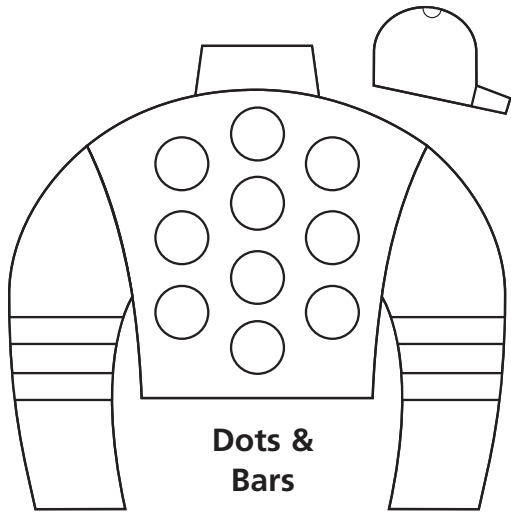


Owners, trainers and the jockey

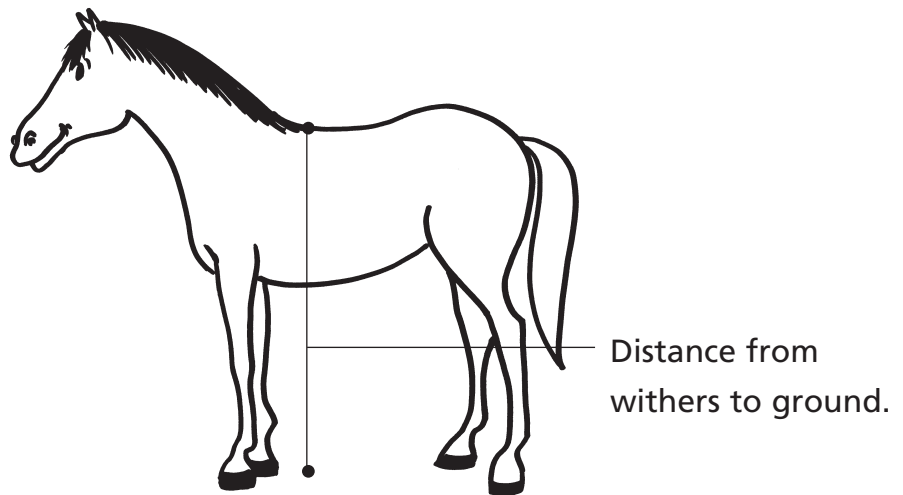

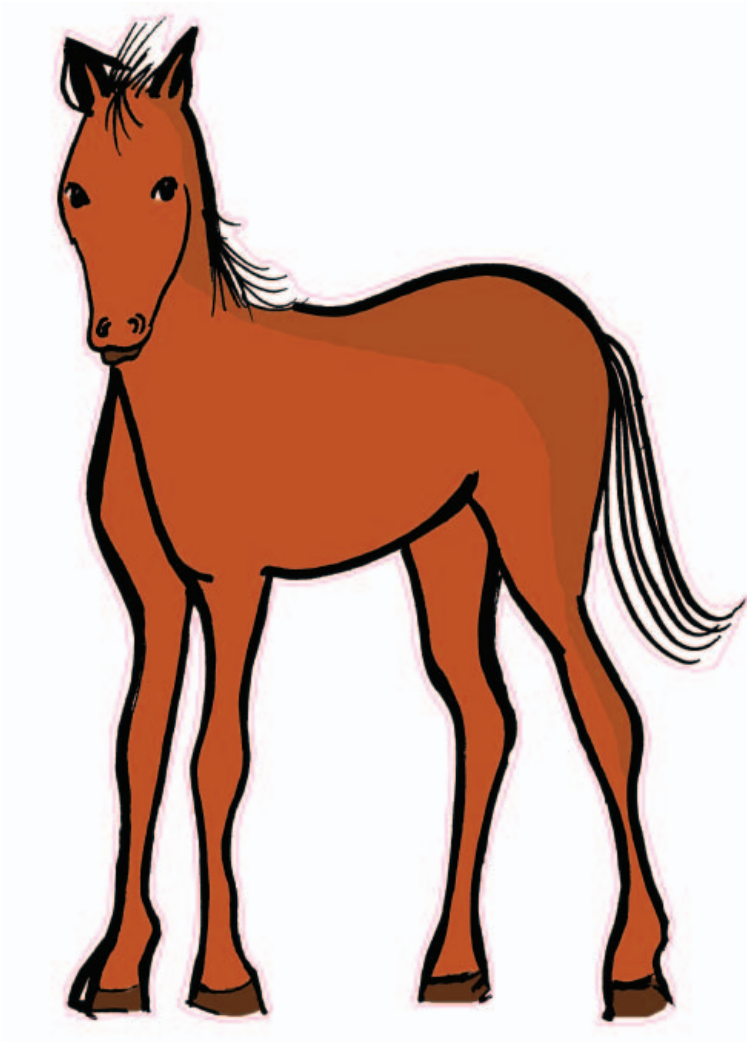

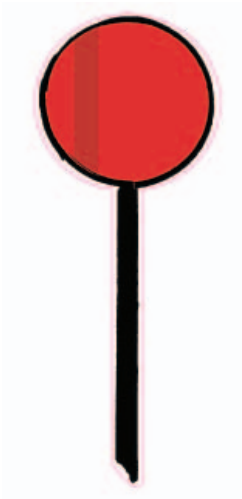
